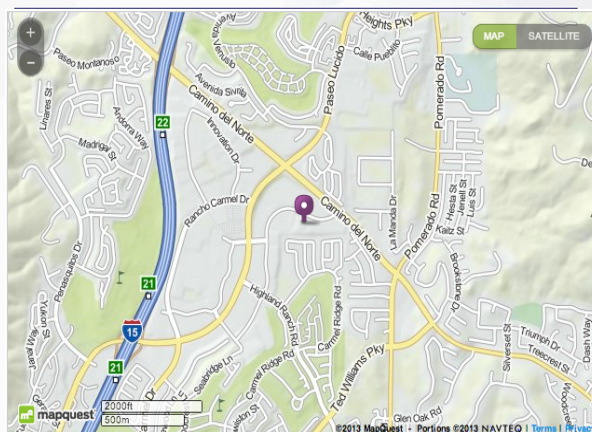
Liza Blumenfeld, MA, CCC-SLP, BRS-S
